

5 FRANK LLOYD WRIGHT HOUSES FOR SALE RIGHT NOW

Own a piece of architectural history.







There are few American architects whose names are as widely known as Frank Lloyd Wright. With 532 of his designs brought to fruition during his lifetime, it was no surprise when this prolific architect, interior designer, and writer was named the "greatest American architect of all time" by the American Institute of Architects in 1991.

"Organic architecture," Wright's design philosophy, involved harmonizing manmade structures, humanity, and environment to develop buildings with fluidity, elegance, and personality. Step inside some of our favorite FLW designs that are currently on the market during what would have been Wright's 150th birthday year.

1 THE CHRISTIE HOUSE



Wright's first house design in New Jersey, the Christie House was built in 1940 on over seven acres of land. The 3-bedroom, 3.5 bathroom home, located in Bernardsville, is currently listed for \$1,875,00.

Aside from incredible interior space and eye-catching design, there is also a cozy artist's studio on the property.

2 TIRRANNA



"Tirranna" is an Aboriginal word that translates to "running waters," which is perfectly fitting for this home as it sits above a waterfall on 15 lush acres of land in New Canaan, <u>Connecticut</u>. The <u>mid-century gem</u> has an impressive seven bedrooms and eight bathrooms, and is listed for \$7.2 million.

3 THE SHERMAN BOOTH HOUSE



This <u>East Glencoe</u>, <u>Illinois property</u> is a unique Wright design, because it is three stories high with a rooftop deck. This 5-bedroom, 4-bathroom home is listed for \$1.9 million and includes a spacious living area that leads to an outdoor lounge overlooking the beautifully-manicured gardens.

4 THE SAMUEL-NAVARRO HOUSE



Built in 1928, <u>the Samuel-Navarro House</u> is both Mayan and Art Decoinspired. Designed for an <u>indoor-outdoor</u> Southern California lifestyle, the design includes a swimmer's pool and plenty of outdoor lounging space. Price available upon request.

5 THE OLFELT HOUSE



The 90-year-old couple who Wright designed this Minnesota home for in the 1950s has decided to sell. With three bedrooms, two bathrooms, floor-to-ceiling windows throughout, and almost four acres of private property, this \$1.395 million is a truly special find.
